A manual brake lever is installed to the side of the steering column of the vehicle and is designed to be used with your right or left hand to operate the brake in the vehicle. You can activate the brake by pushing the lever towards the dashboard, or in a downwards motion. A manual brake lever can be used on its own, or it can be paired with a gas ring.

A manual brake lever comes with horn, hill holder and economizer function as standard. The hill holder function acts like a park brake, leaving your hands free to change gears or adjust other functions in the vehicle. When activated the 'economizer' reduces the power of acceleration by 50%. Allowing ease when parking and driving in traffic, where less power is required.
